An inquest was held by Mr. Wilson, at Fittleton, on Monday last on the body of Mary Blackmore, who died very suddenly on the Friday evening previous, without any previous illness. And another inquest was held by the same coroner at Martin, on Wednesday, on the body of Mrs Sarah Bound, who dropped down dead whilst dressing herself on Sunday morning.
