I Anna Maria Poore of Melksham in the County of Wilts Widow do hereby revoke & make void all Wills & Testaments by me formerly made & do publish & declare this to be my last Will & Testament as follows (that is to say) first I give & bequeath unto my Son Edward Poore my Gold Watch & seals I give & bequeath to my Sister Charlotte Sumpter the Sum of Twenty Pounds I give & bequeath to my Sister Eleanor Wallis ten pounds I give & bequeath to my sister Arabella Woodford ten pounds I give & bequeath to my Sister Harriet Curtis ten pounds to be paid by my Exor hereinafter named within a month after my decease And it is my desire to be buried in the same Vault in which my dear Husband was interred and that a friend or two would attend me to the Church All the rest residue and remainder of my Goods Chattles monies Plate Securities for money money in the Public funds Personals & expectancy of monies & Personal Property of what nature soever & wheresoever lying & being After my Debts Legacies as aforesaid & funeral Expences are thereout first paid I give & bequeath to my said Son Edward Poore and I do hereby make constitute & appoint my said Son Edward Poore sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have to this my said Will contained in one sheet of Paper set my hand & Seal set my hand & Seal the Seventh day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven *Anna Maria Poore*
