Inquest held by G. M. Sylvester, esq. –

At Mere, on Henry Pressley, aged 10 months. The deceased was placed under the care of a person who left him in the house. On the return of the individual she found the deceased had crept out into the garden, and falling into some water was drowned. Verdict – Accidentally Drowned.
