



The Pub With Two Names!

You can just see the name of the pub Railway Inn in the first photo showing the row of coal bunkers opposite, but this pub is unique as it has two names officially registered. The other name being The Dust Hole. The coal bunkers opposite would have created clouds of dust as the coalmen went about their daily work. It was named the Railway Inn initially as Milford was where Salisbury's first station was built in 1847 and was used for more than a decade.

Then when Salisbury station opened up Milford Station was used as a Goods station, but later a fire destroyed the station. Where Milford Station was, now stands modern flats called appropriately The Sidings.

The pub was in the Guinness Book of records for a while as the only officially registered pubs with two names. It is still in use today.
