### Claims Court

Thomas Boulton v Jacob Andrews

Thomas Boulton, of Minety, farmer v Jacob Andrews of same place, cattle dealer. Claim £16 17s 4d, balance of account.

Mr Handy, for plaintiff, and Mr Jones for the defence. In this case time for the arbitrator's certificate was enlarged to the 5<sup>th</sup> November next inclusive.

The amount claimed was £16 17s 4d, and it will be remembered that at the September court the case was referred to Mr T H Chubb, the deputy-registrar. Mr Chubb's certificate was now entered, and judgement was recorded for £16 9s 10d, and costs.
