### **Claims Court**

Arthur Habgood v Walter Poole

Arthur Habgood, of Purton, grocer, v Walter Poole, innkeeper, of Minety. Claim for £17 2s 2d.

£2 2s 2d of the debt was for grocery goods, which was admitted and paid into court.

The balance was the price of a horse, which plaintiff said he sold to defendant, and which died, but which defendant said he only had sent to him on approval.

The evidence on the latter point was not clear, and plaintiff was non-suited.
