Elijah Kinnett v Jonathan Read

Elijah Kinnett, of Purton, claimed £2 13s 6d of Jonathan Read, of Minety, being 13s 6d money paid by plaintiff under an illegal execution levied upon his goods by the defendant, and £2 damages.

Mr Withy, for the plaintiff, stated that execution had been levied by the bailiffs at the wrong house and 13s 6d was paid to obviate a sale of the goods.

Defendant had received the 13s 6d and had refused to refund it.

Judgement for plaintiff for £1 13s 6d.
