## **Court Case**

## Walter Titcumb

On Saturday, Walter Titcumb, of Minety, was brought up in custody before T Luce, Esq., and was charged with stealing a hive of bees, the property of his master, Mr Charles Brown, on the 29<sup>th</sup> March.

The prosecutor having stated the circumstances under which the hive was taken (and which it would appear from his statement was done for a "lark" by one of the villagers), applied for a release of the prisoner, as he believed him to be wholly innocent of the affair, and expressed his determination to offer a reward for the detection of the actual offender.

The prisoner was discharged accordingly.
