Mr Whitmarsh held an inquest on Tuesday last, at Minety, on the body of Mr Christopher Cole, of Parsonage House, in the parish. Mr Cole was in his usual robust health on Saturday last, and having ate a hearty breakfast walked to an adjoining farm. About an hour afterwards he felt unwell, returned to his house, retired to bed, and within a very short time was a corpse. He was in the 58th year of his age.

The jury returned their verdict; "Died by the visitation of God."
