

Coroner's Inquest Report Minety

New born child

Inquest at Minety, on the body of a new born male child, which died the day after it was born, before the arrival of the doctor who was called in to attend it, the mother having been delivered under the care of a midwife. The doctor on examining the body found it in a congested state, caused probably from imperfection of the heart preventing the proper circulation necessary for life, which led to the death of the child.

Verdict in accordance with medical testimony.
