Sir David Gamble

Sir David Gamble, who has died at his Wiltshire residence, White Lodge, Braydon, was a practical agriculturalist, having studied at the Royal Agricultural College, Cirencester.

When in 1928 he took over the White Lodge Estate, which had become somewhat neglected, he used intensive methods to bring it back to prosperous cultivation, and worked as hard as any of his employees.

He was a member of both the Farmers' Union and the County Agricultural Committee.

He took a prominent part in village affairs at Minety, and during the long illness of the late Vicar (the Rev T A Ludlow-Hewitt) Sir David assisted as a layman with the carrying on of the church services.
