



Village Hall

Sir David Gamble, Bart, presided at a meeting of the Village Hall Committee on Monday, other present being:- Landy Gamble, Mr. E. E. Taylor, Mr. C. S. Stratford, Mrs. E. E. Taylor, Mr. H. V. Cook, Mr. E. R. New, Mr. P. H. Miles, Mr. C. E. Meakin (hon. treasurer), Mr. A. S. Woodward (hon. secretary) and Mr. G. Clayton (assistant secretary).

The Treasurer's statement revealed a debit of £0. 2s. 9d. but it was stated that the funds would be augmented when the amount due for the hire of the hall for a school had been received from the Wilts Education Committee. Arrangements were made for holding a whist drive and dance in aid of the National Institute for the Blind. In view of the extra duties for the caretaker caused by the hall being used as a school for the evacuated children in the village, it was decided to increase his wages to 18s. per week.
