All Persons desirous of Contracting with the Guardians of the above Union, for supplying the Relieving Officers of the undermentioned Districts with the following Articles, from Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> of December instant, to the 25<sup>th</sup> March next, are requested to attend the Meeting of the Board of Guardians, at the White Hart Inn, Malmesbury, on Saturday, the 19<sup>th</sup> inst., at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, with Tenders and samples.

FLOUR, Best Seconds, at.....per Bag

BREAD, Best Seconds, in Gallon, Half Gallon, and Quarter Gallon Loaves, at.....per Gallon

The articles to be delivered in the several Parishes at such times and places, and in such quantities, as the Board of Guardians shall direct.

Security will be required for the performance of the Contracts.

The Districts above referred to contain the following Parishes, and for supplying either of which Districts, or the three together, Tenders will be received:--

District No 1 – Hullavington, Somerford Magna, Somerford Parva, Dauntsey, Malmesbury Saint Paul, Malmesbury Saint Mary Westport, Malmesbury Saint Mary the Abbey.

District No 2 – Bremelham, Brokenborough, Foxley, Norton, Easton Grey, Sheraton Magna, Sheraton Pinkney, Sopworth, Luckington, Alderton.

District No 3 – Minety, Oaksey, Crudwell and Eastcourt, Hankerton, Charlton, Garsdon, Lea and Cleverton, Brinkworth.
