In the Name of God Amen The Eight and Twentieth day of September in the fourth year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lady Anne by the grace of God Queen of England Scotland France and Ireland etc and in the year of our Lord 1705 I John Poulton of Monkton Deverill in the County of Wilts Gent being of a sound and perfect mind and memory thanks by given to Almighty God for the same And considering the certainty of Death and the uncertain time thereof Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in writing in manner and form following first I commend my Soul to Almighty god who gave it hoping assuredly by the Merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour and Redeemer to have Everlasting Salvation And my Body I committ to the Earth from whence it came to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named And as concerning my Estate and worldly Goods which it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I do give bequeath and dispose the same as followeth first I give and bequeath unto my two well beloved Sisters Mary Shoare and Anne Beach Twenty shillings each to be paid to each of them within one Month after my Decease if they or each of them shall happen to survive me by my Executor hereinafter named Item I give unto my well beloved Nephew John Poulton of

the Parish of St Mary Magdalene in the Burrough of Southwark Gent All my Moneys Goods Chattles Household stuff Debts and personall Estate whatsoever And I do also by these presents make nominate constitute and appoint him the said John Poulton my Nephew Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made In Wittness whereof I the above named John Poulton have hereunto sett my hand and seal the day and Year first above written *John Poulton*
