



Richard Craduck of Blackeney aforesaid Blacksmith the Sum of Twenty Pounds Stock the remainder of the said one hundred and Twenty Pounds Stock (One hundred pounds of which is by me before bequeathed to my said Brother Noah) and also Eighty Pounds Stock now also standing in my Name in the said four percent Annuities I give and bequeath my watch unto Ann Powell daughter of my Nephew John Powell of Broadoak Shipwright I give and bequeath all my Linen and wearing apparel unto my Sister Christian Craduck and my Niece Catharine Powell Daughter of my Brother Noah to be equally divided between them as near as may be in point of value and as to all other my personal Estate and Effects I give the same to my Nephew John Powell of Broad Oak whom I do nominate and appoint Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Eleventh day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and one Ann Powell
