



## Inquest Report on George Harper

### INQUEST TAKEN BEFORE MR. WHITMARSH

An inquest has been held by Mr. Sylvester at Southwick, on George Harper, who was reported to have lost his life by violence, having been beaten by some persons of the village on his return home about ten days previous to his death; but medical evidence proved epilepsy to have been the cause, to which had been subject for many years. Verdict – died from natural causes.
