



Inquest Report on George Rose

Inquests taken by S. A. Sylvester, esq.

At Yarnbrook, parish of North Bradley, on George Rose, aged one year. The deceased was sitting in a chair near the fire, on which was a kettleful of boiling water. The man took it off and placed it on the hob, when some water issued from the spout and went over the deceased, causing extensive scalds and death the same day.

Verdict – “Accidental Death.”
