

Bottlesford, North Newnton World War I Casualty Biographies

Private Herbert James Barlow

Herbert James Barlow was born in Windsor, Berkshire, lived at Yew Cottage, Bottlesford, Pewsey, Wiltshire and enlisted at Devizes. Serving in the B Coy., 5th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment, he was killed in action in Mesopotamia on 18 April 1916, aged 18 years 6 months. His service number was 21017. His name is commemorated on the Basra Memorial in Iraq, and on the North Newnton Church War Memorial in Hilcott Cemetery and in the North Newnton Church Roll of Honour. He is also named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book. He was the eldest son of Jesse and Janet May Barlow of Bottlesford, Marlborough, Wilts.
