Benett	Etheldred	<p>In Memory of ETHELDRED second daughter of THOMAS BENETT Esqr. of Pythouse and CATHERINE his Wife, who died January 11th 1845, Aged 69 She had been 43 years an inhabitant of the Mansion House in this Parish of Norton Bavant.</p>
Benett	Fanny	<p>To the Memory of FANNY youngest Daughter of JOHN BENETT Esqre. of Pythouse, and of this Place; and of LUCY LAMBERT, his Wife. Born February 24th 1821 Died at Westbury, April 28th 1858. In the world ye shall have tribulation; nut be of good cheer, I have overcome the world. John XVI, 33.</p>
Benett	John	<p>In memory of JOHN BENETT son of JOHN BENETT & LUCYLAMBERT his wife born 1909 married 1836 Emily daughter of Sir HENRY TICHBOURNE Bart. Died at Funchal, in the island of Madeira. Dec 26th 1844 was embalmed, brought home & buried in the Catholic Cemetery at Wardour in this county R.I.P.</p>

Benett	John	<p>In Memory of JOHN BENETT Esq. of Pythouse He was eldest surviving son and heir of THOMAS BENETT Esq. of Pythouse and Norton Bavant by CATHERINE his wife, daughter of JOHN DARELL Esq. He married Lucy daughter of EDMUND LAMBERT Esq. of Boyton and died 1 October 1852 Aged 79 Years He was Member of Parliament for the County of Wilts 32 years, also a Magistrate and Deputy Lieutenant for the Shire County</p>
Benett	John Edward	<p>In memory of JOHN EDWARD BENETT son of the above he died April 29th 1856, aged 16, at Nice in the S of France, & buried there. R.I.P.</p>
Benett	William	<p>In Memoria Æterna Eit Justus In the Family Vault in the nave of this Church, rests in hope of Eternal Life, the Body of WILLIAM 3rd Son of THOMAS BENETT and CATHARINE (DARELL) his Wife of Pyehouse and of this Place. He was Born Feby. 24th 1779, and Died August 25th 1859. His Wife ELLEN only Daughter of THOMAS GORE Esqr. of Tring Parish in the County of Herts. As also four of their Children are Buried in the Church of St. Mary the Virgin, Kensington.</p>

Benet-Stanford	Vere	<p>In loving memory of VERE BENET-STANFORD J.P. D.L. of Norton Bavant and Pyt House, Wilts. And Preston, Sussex. Who died May 8th 1894, in Madeira where he was also buried, aged 54 Having found what Earth can never give ~ Death's Treasure ~ Rest This Brass is erected by Ellen, his widow.</p>
Benett-Stanford	John M.	<p>To the Memory of Lt Col, JOHN M. BENETT-STANFORD Born 5 Febry. 1870 Died 18th Novr. 1947. Joining the Wilts Militia 1888 & the Royal Dragoons 1890 He saw active service on the Indian Frontier 1896-97, Nile 1897, South African War 1898 1902 & the Great War 1914-1918 Alderman the Wilts County Council 1895-1901 Member for Heytesbury 1904-1919 & Justice of the Peace for Wilts & Dorset The Son of Vere & Father of Vere R.I.P.</p>
Benett-Stanford	Evelyn	<p>In Memory of EVELYN BENETT-STANFORD Wife of the Above 1869 ~ 1957</p>

Benett-Stanford	Vere	<p style="text-align: center;">Vere only Son of JOHN and EVELYN BENETT-STANFORD of Pythouse and Norton Bavent Major in the Royal Regt. Of Artillery. Born 3rd April 1894 Died 20th May 1922 The last of the Benetts of Norton Bavant, The last of the Stanfords of Preston, Sussex. By his heroic action, during an attack in the Great War in France, in giving up his gas mask to his Sergeant he contracted the illness from which he died for which act he was awarded the Military Cross "Dulce et Decorum est pro Patria Mori" Floreat Etona.</p>
Eliot	Elizabeth Kyd	<p style="text-align: center;">To the memory of ELIZABETH KYD ELIOT Daughter of the Hon. J.B. SKEETE and wife of the Rev. EDW ELIOT Vicar of this parish and formerly Archdeacon of Barbados Her life was eminently & consistently Christian and her distinguishing ornament "A meek and quiet spirit" She died January 6th 1855 Aged 54 Years</p>
Eliot	Richard	<p style="text-align: center;">To the memory of The Rev. RICHARD ELIOT, M.A. Student of Ch: Ch: Oxford second son of the Rev. EDWARD ELIOT, (Formerly Vicar of this parish) and of ELIZABETH KYD, his wife He died May 14th 1862, Aged 31 Erected by his sorrowing brothers and sisters.</p>

Torrance	Julia	<p style="text-align: center;">To the Glory of God and in loving Memory of JULIA TORRANCE Born April 5 1829 Died Sept 14 1899 This memorial is placed by ELINOR MANNING and by many members of the Women's Union</p>

Who departed this Life the 27th of . . . </p>
