On Thursday, as some workmen in the employ of Mr. Josiah Read, who were threshing wheat by steam, had just finished, one of them, named Morris, stepped into the drum of the machine. Before it could be stopped the man's right foot and leg were terribly lacerated, and it was with some difficulty that he was extricated. He was immediately conveyed to the Salisbury Infirmary, when the limb was amputated above the knee.
