As a result of coming into collision with a lorry and private car in Cirencester on February 15, Thomas F C Bown, of Oaksey, near Malmesbury, was at Cirencester Magistrates Court on Wednesday, fined £2 for driving a car with an inefficient braking system,.

In a letter to the court, Bown pleaded guilty, adding that he was just driving his car to a local garage to have his brakes maintained. He had been driving since 1939, and this was his first offence.
