Among his property were found 144 crown pieces, of the reign of Queen Anne, which appeared to have been but little circulated; 20 half crowns, a number of bank notes and guineas; besides several large and curious gold pieces of considerable value. Mr J, being a bachelor, his landed property, which was copyhold, descends to the Lord of the Manor of Oaksey.
