## *Oaksey*

### **Rev Joseph Storr**

In our obituary columns to-day is an intimation of the death at Leeds, while on holiday, of the Rev Joseph Storr, vicar of Sevenhampton, near Andoversford, at the age of 76.

Mr Storr, who was a graduate of London University, was ordained at Winchester in 1877, and licensed to a curacy at St Michael's, Bournemouth. After holding further curacies at Branksome (Bournemouth), and Brotherloft (Lincoln), he came to the Gloucester diocese, and was successively curate of Whelford (1880-8), and Oaksey (1888-90), before accepting the invitation of the Bishop of Gloucester to become vicar of Sevenhampton in 1890. There he has laboured for the past thirty-three years on a stipend that averaged £120 a year with a house.
