Rev W A Norris

It is with regret that we announce the death on April 16, at Halifax, of the Rev W A Norris, Vicar of Floore.

Deceased was educated at Trinity College, Cambridge, took his B.A. degree in 1854, and his M.A. in 1857. He was curate of Langley, in Worcestershire from 1854 to 1856, when he went to Alresford, where he remained about a year, and then officiated at Feliskirk, in Yorkshire, till 1860.

He was then appointed to the living of Oaksey, near Cirencester—patron, Captain Mullins; income, £460; population, 450.—where he remained until 1875, when he was offered and accepted the living at Floore—patron, Christ Church, Oxford; income, £650; population, 1,019—where he remained till his death.

During his ministry in this village, he had gathered around him many friends, and was greatly respected by rich and poor alike.
