In the Name of God Amen

The Eighth day of January in the year of our Lord God 1702/3 I Henry Golsey Rector of Oaksey in the County of Wilts being sound in body and of perfect mind and memory thanks being given unto God therefore calling into mind the mortality of my Body knowing that it is appointed for all men sure to dye so make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say First and principally I give my Soul into the hands of God who gave it me and for my Body I commend it to the Earth to be buried in decent manner according to the direction of my Executrix hereafter named and touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I do hereby give and bequeath unto my dear and welbeloved Wife Rachel all my Goods Chattels Stores Bills Bonds Debts ready money Plate and all my Goods within door and without and whatsoever I shall stand possessed of at the time of my death or shall in any wise in Law or Equity of right belong to me and I do hereby constitute and appoint my Wife Rachel to be sole and full Executrix of this my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal the day and year above written
