1802

On Thursday was married, at Odstock, by the Rev John Bedwell, the Rev. J. Matthews, Vicar of Berwick St James, to Miss Pippett, of Shepton Mallett, Somerset. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 15 November 1802**

1817

On Monday morning last, died London, the Rev Arthur Stert May, Rector of Odstock, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 9 June 1817**

1823

On Monday last was married, by the Rev. Mr Grove, Mr Henry Cook, of Nunton, to Miss Mary Ann Martin, only daughter of the late Mr Thos. Martin, of Odstock, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 6 January 1823**

Tuesday died, at advanced age, Mr John Brazier, carpenter, of Odstock, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 3 February 1823**

Salisbury On Sunday the 3rd inst., died after a short but severe illness, Mr Thomas Martin, of Knighton Park Farm, near Canford, Dorset. He was the eldest son of the late Mr Thomas Martin, of Odstock, near this city, and departed this life in the 45th year of his age, greatly lamented by all who knew him. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 11 August 1823**

1828

At Odstock, in the county of Wilts, William Grove, Esq, third son of Thomas Grove, Esq. of Fern, in the same county, to Frances Harriet, eldest daughter of the late Charles Grove, Esq. M.D., Salisbury. **Cambridge Chronicle and Journal 10 October 1828**

1843

May 6, at the residence of her son, the Rev. Charles Grove, Odstock Rectory, near Salisbury, in the 85th year of her age, Elisabeth, relict of Charles Grove, Esq., M.D., and eldest sister the late Sir John Palmer Acland, Bart., Fairfield, Somerset. **Exeter and Plymouth Gazette 13 May 1843**

1845

Deaths April 8, at Odstock, after a few days illness, Mr Thomas Champion, in his 80th year. **Wiltshire**
