This is the final agreemt made in the Court of our Sovereign Lord the King at Westmtr. Easter day in ffifteen days in the fourteen year of the Reign of George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain ffrance and Ireland King Defender of the ffaith pt before John Willes John ffortescue aland William ffortescue & Thomas Parker Justices of Our Lord King & others then & there present & Between Edward Grinfield Esqr. Prt. and Edward Godden Esqr. & Elizabeth
