

Overton Non-Conformist Meeting Houses and Chapels

There are records of a Wesleyan church in a house in West Overton in 1819. A new building was constructed on Overton Heath in 1846. This was superseded by a chapel built in West Overton in 1911 which operated until 1966 when it closed (Kelly Directory 1907). The meetings then moved to Lockeridge.
