CHAPLIN, Thomas - Sergeant 31674 - 3rd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - died 17th July 1916 - age 46 - son of John & Sarah Chaplin; husband of Beatrice E. Chaplin of The Butts, Potterne - Grave Reference:- H. 42A

DAVIDSON, John Duncan - Engineer Lieutenant – Royal Naval Reserve - served aboard H.M.S. Lady Moyra - died 15th May 1919 - age 32 - husband of Mary Davidson of High Street, Potterne - Grave Reference:- H. 21

HAMPTON, G. R. - Driver T/14716268 - Royal Army Service Corps - died 6th December 1947 – Grave Reference:- Grave 254

RUDMAN, Percy - Signaller 14543636 - 2 L. of C. Signals, Royal Corps of Signals – died 27<sup>th</sup> Jan 1944 – Grave Reference:- C. of E. Grave 273

TILLEY, Harry Cleford - Able Seaman D/JX 194882 - Royal Navy - served aboard H.M.S. President III - died 12th May 1942 - Grave Reference:- C. of E. Grave 157

WATTS, Harry Edward Cecil - Sapper 1990795 - 723 Artisan Works Company, Royal Engineers - died 12th July 1941 -age 24 - son of Al
