To all Christian people to whom these psents shall come Know yee that I Thomas Priddy of Pirton in the County of Wilts Miller doe make my last Will and Testament in manner and forme as followeth ffirst I give my Soule to Almighty God who gave it and my body to be buried in Pirton Church yard and my worldly goods as it alsoe followeth Imprimis I give after

my decease to my wife Six pounds by the yeare and the bed which wee now lyes in but if she and my Executor can agree to live together then it is my Will that my wife Shall have her bed meate and Drinke washing and wringing and forty shillings by the yeare I give to my brother Henry ten shillings and to his children twelve pence a peice Item I give to my Godsonne John Pedlingham twelve pence Item I give to my Godsonne Thomas Welles twelve pence Item I give to my Sister Margery Pedlingham twelve pence Item I make my kinsman Thomas Priddy my whole Executor of all my goods both within doores and without and all my writings or any goods whatsoever And I Doe appoint Robert Gleed the younger and John Dathe to be Overseers of this my last Will and Testament In witnes whereof I have hereunto Sett my hand and Seale Dated the Seven and twentyeth Day of May and in the yeare of our Lord God one thousand Six hundred and fifty six Thomas Priddy his marke
