COMMITTED TO BRIDEWELL, MARLBOROUGH --- John Stone, for six weeks, for leaving the service of John Rowland, at Ramsbury **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday 22 February 1838**

1843

Wilts Epiphany Sessions Daniel Rolph, charged with having stolen one paint brush, and eighteen squares of glass, the property of James Luker, at Ramsbury. Guilty: 9 months imprisonment. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**

Wilts Epiphany Sessions James Scott, charged with having stolen one quart of milk, the property of Jane Martin, at Ramsbury. Guilty: 7 years transportation. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**

Wilts Epiphany Sessions R. Vaisey Fosbury, charged with having assaulted J. Butler, Constable, of Ramsbury, in the execution of his duty. Guilty; 48 hours imprisonment, and fined £10. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
