



CORONERS INQUESTS *Ramsbury*



Inquest of Fanny Woolford 1878

On Saturday last, Mr. W. R. WHITMARSH held an inquest, at Ramsbury, on the body of Fanny, daughter of Ambrose Woolford, labourer, 18 months old.

It appeared in evidence that in the evening of Wednesday the grandmother had been washing, when she took some things out of a pan of water and went into the garden to dry them. On her return the child had fallen into the pan outside the door and was suffocated. Verdict : "Accidental death".
