

CORONERS INQUESTS Ramsbury



Inquest of Fanny Woolford 1878

On Saturday last, Mr. W. R. WHITMARSH held an inquest, at Ramsbury, on the body of Fanny, daughter of Ambrose Woolford , labourer, 18 months old.

It appeared in evidence that in the evening of Wednesday the grandmother had been washing, when she took some things out of a pan of water and went into the garden to dry them. On her return the child had fallen into the pan outside the door and was suffocated. Verdict: "Accidental death".
