Rowde 1850-1899

Inquests taken before Mr. Coroner Sylvester. At Rowde, on Walter John Duckland, aged 6 months. This infant could not be suckled in consequence of his mother having puerperal mania; he was consequently delicate, and diarrhoea attacked him on Friday last and caused death on Sunday morning. Verdict – Natural Causes. Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 25 January 1866
