who was born June 10<sup>th</sup>, 1787,  
and died Dec<sup>r</sup>. 12<sup>th</sup> 1835

Beloved  
for the gentleness of his temper  
and  
the suavity of his manners;  
Virtuous and religious from principle;  
And preferring the calm pleasures of Study  
to the more active occupations  
of the military Profession,  
He maintained through life  
the Character of a good and accomplished Man,  
and died in the faith and hope of a true Christian.

is erected by his only and elder Brother  
in whose Canonry house in this Close he expired,  
and by whom  
his Memory will be long and justly cherished.
