



FORESTER'S FUNERAL.

On Tuesday last the mortal remains of Brother Henry Sworn, one of the oldest members of Court "Egerton and Wyndham" (No. 3260) of the Ancient Order of Foresters, were interred in Salisbury Cemetery. He was carried to his last resting place by some of the brethren of the Court to which he belonged. Between 30 and 40 brothers followed the corpse. The brothers on their return from the grave went to their Court-room, at the Crystal Fountain Inn, where a vote of thanks was proposed and unanimously carried, to Brother Cox, the indefatigable secretary, for the manner in which on so short a notice, he summoned the brothers on the occasion.
