This is the last Will and Testament of Charles Bayliffe of Seagry in the County of Wilts Gent made this ffive and twentieth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two Imprimis I give and devise unto my Wife the rents and Profitts of all my Copyhold Lands according to the Customs of the respective Mannors wherein they lye And also I give and devise unto my said Wife and her Assignes during her natural Life one annuity or yearly Sum of Eighty Pounds of Lawfull Brittish money to be issuing and payable out of all my ffreehold Lands and Estate to be paid by half yearly and equal Payments in Lieu and Satisfaction of all Dower and Thirds at Common Law which she can have or Claime in or out of all my ffreehold Lands and Estate in case She shall think fit to Accept of the same I also give to my Wife the ffurniture of any one room of either of my Dwelling houses at her Election Item I give unto my Son Charles

Bayliffe his heirs Executors and Assigns All my freehold and Leasehold Lands Tenements and Hereditaments in Seagry aforesaid Subject to the Payment of my Debts and Legacies as hereinafter mentioned And Subject to the Payment of One Moiety of the Eighty Pounds per Annum hereinbefore Devised to my Wife Item I give unto my Son Richard Bayliffe his heirs Executors and Assigns All my freehold and Leasehold Lands Tenements and Hereditaments in Titherton alias Titherton Keyly... in the Parish of Bremhill or Keylways in the said County of Wilts Subject to the Payment of my Debts and Legacies as hereinafter is mentioned And Subject to the Payment of the other Moiety of the Eighty Pounds per Annum hereinbefore Devised to my Wife Item I give unto my four Daughters the Sum of Eight hundred Pounds a peice to be paid to them with interest at the rate of four Pounds per Centum per Annum as soon as it can conveniently be raised out of my Personal Estate And in case the same shall not be Sufficient to pay the Debts and Legacies Then I direct and devise that one Moiety of my said Legacies to my Daughters or so much thereof as my Personal estate shall be deficient to Answer shall be paid by my Son Charles Bayliffe and his heirs out of the Lands hereby to him devised aforesaid And I direct and devise that the other Moiety of my said Legacies to my Daughters or so much thereof as my Personal estate shall be deficient to Answer shall be paid by my Son Richard Bayliffe and his heirs out of the Lands hereby to him devised aforesaid All the rest and residue of my Estate both real and Personal I give and devise unto my said Sons Charles Bayliffe and Richard Bayliffe their heirs Extors and Admors after the performance of the Trusts aforesaid And I Constitute and appoint my said Sons Charles Bayliffe and Richard Bayliffe sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Charles Bayliffe have hereunto set my hand and Seal and published and declared this to be my last Will and Testament the day and year above written *C Bayliffe*
