



Bishop's Transcripts Identified

In April 2011 archivists at Wiltshire and Swindon History Centre confirmed that part of a BT's manuscript could be accredited to belonging to the parish of Sedgemoor.

The segment identified Baptisms, Marriages and Burials. It is assumed that the archivists were able to identify the piece as Sedgemoor from the names of the Minister and Churchwardens who has signed their names to the document.
