Mr H S Awdry

Mr H S Awdry, a member of a greatly respected old Wiltshire family, and third son of the late Mr Ambrose Awdry, squire of Seend, Wilts, passed away at 11 Pulteney Street, Bath, on Saturday, at the age of 77.

Mr Awdry's genial and gentle nature endeared him to everyone whom he knew. He was at one time an interested amateur philatelist, but had not added to his stamp collection in recent years. Coming from a county family, it was natural that in former years, his pastimes included shooting and fishing.

Mr Ambrose Awdry, his father, lived for some time at 35 Pulteney Street, Bath, when his family were children at school, and after an interval returned to Pultenev Street and died there. The principal mourners were: Miss Awdry (sister), Commander E W Salisbury (nephew), Mrs Seymour Awdry (sister-inlaw), Mr Edmund Awdry (Chippenham), Mr and Mrs Awdry (Farleigh), Mr Radcliffe Awdry and Mr Bodly Awdry (great nephews), maids at the Bungalow, Mr T Derrick (orderly), Mr Spenser and Nurse Turle. The interment was made at the family vault at Bathwick Cemetery.
