



Philip Charles Alexander Usher

Squadron-Leader the Rev Philip Charles Alexander Usher, RAFVR, of Seend Green House, Seend, Wilts, Chaplain in the RAF, Chaplain of Grosvenor Chapel, South Audley Street, and for nine years editor of the "Church Quarterly Review", formerly Domestic Chaplain to the Bishop of Gloucester, who died on active service last June, aged 42 years, son of the late Thomas Charles Usher, head of the Wiltshire Brewery, left gross estate of the value of £15,369 4s 5d with net personally £15,352 3s 5d.

Mr Austin Gerald Comyn King of 13 Queen Square, Bath, Solicitor is executor. Testator left £250 each to his godchildren, Anne Danby and Philip James Dunlop, on attaining the age of 21 years; £50 each to his executors; and the residue of the property to his sister Constance Irene Usher.
