



Mr Joseph Trigge Schomberg, QC, recorder of Aldborough, died on Sunday at his seat at Seend, near Melksham. He was the fourth son of the late Captain Schomberg, RN, by Miss Amelia Brodrick, great granddaughter of the first Viscount Middleton, sometime Lord Chancellor of Ireland. He was born on August 14, 1805, educated at Winchester, and called to the bar at the Inner Temple in 1828. He married in 1834 a daughter of the late Rev W C Ray, rector of Pakenham, by whom he has issue eight sons and six daughters. He was appointed recorder of Aldborough in 1845.
