This is the last Will and Testament of me Hannah Awdrey of Seend in the County of Wilts widow I give to my Sister Jane Shield the sum of five guineas and to my niece Ann Shield the like sum of five guineas which I request them to accept and lay out in the purchase of some memorial of my affection and regard I give to each of my nieces Kate Guy Eliza Guy Charlotte Williamson Julia Hines Emma Hensley Amelia Podmore and Ellen Guy the sum of ten guineas and to each of my nephews Anthony Guy John Guy and Henry Guy the like sum of ten guineas I give to each of my nieces Elizabeth Awdrey and Ellen Seymour Awdrey the sum of fifty pounds and to my nephew Ambrose Awdrey the like sum of fifty pounds I give to each of my nieces Georgiana Awdrey and Arabella Awdrey the sum of ten guineas and to each of my nephews West Awdrey Edward Charles Awdrey ffrederick Awdrey Justly William Awdrey Peter Awdrey and Charles Hill Awdrey the sum of ten guineas I give to the Salisbury and Wiltshire Infirmary the sum of ten pounds And I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer shall be a sufficient discharge for the same and All the Residue and Remainder of my monies securities for money Personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever which I may be possessed of at the time of my decease I give and bequeath unto my sister Elizabeth Awdrey for her life and after her decease I give the same unto my said niece Ellen Seymour Awdrey for her own absolute use and benefit except my Cedar Work Table which I give with all its contents to my niece Elizabeth Awdrey I appoint the said West Awdrey and Ambrose Awdrey joint Executors of this my will In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand this twenty second day of March one thousand eight hundred and forty five The Mark X of Hannah Awdrey
