Death of Mr. Brown, Jnr., by Drowning

On Saturday morning, the naked body of a young man was found on the banks of the Humber at Barrow Haven. The remains were those of a London newspaper reporter, who had been attending the meetings of the Congregational Union at Hull, and whose clothes had previously been found on the bank near where the body was discovered. The name of A. J. Brown was marked on the clothing. The young man was the son of Mr. Brown, of Harthill Farm, Semley. A London evening paper says Mr. Brown was often to be seen at religious meetings in the Metropolis, and his kind-heartedness made him a general favourite with his colleagues
