



A New Registrar

Mr. Charles Blandford, of the Post Office, Brookwater, has been appointed the registrar of births and deaths, in succession to the late Mr. A. Jukes, for the sub-district of Donhead, which comprises the parishes of the Donheads (2), Semley, Alvediston, Berwick St. John and Tollard Royal.

A long felt want had been supplied by this new appointment. Under the old system people had to walk a distance of 14 to 24 miles to register a birth or death.

The question has been brought before the Parish Council on several occasions and the District Council has been communicated with.

In view of the appointment of a resident registrar, the appointment has given much satisfaction.
