



## Extracts from Shorncote Burials Parish Register

### 1809

There was no funeral at Shorncutt since the Rev'd Jas Morgan was buried Jany. 12<sup>th</sup> 1809. He was Curate of the parish for many years. [presumably the next burial 1816]. For upwards of twenty years.

### 1816

Mary Mill buried 12 April.

Buried in a brick grave and afterwards put into the vault, at the burial of her father, William Mill, in 1820.

### 1830

Sarah Brooks lived at the cottage on the Glebe called Bunon[?] Hill near Shotncutt & was taken thence to Shorncutt & buried near to Mary Brooks.

### 1831

Sarah Kimpsford buried 23 November. There was a certificate from the Surgeon, who attended Sarah Kimpsford, that she died by the Visitation of God.

### 1833

Robert Brooks buried 9 January. He fell into the canal at Siddington on Sunday 6 Jany. 1833.

### 1840

Sarah buried September {day unclear}. A travelling woman came to Shorncutt on the Saturday & died Sunday about 9 pm, buried by Coroners warrant on day and date above.

### 1843

Mary Weeks buried 11 August. Widow of William. She was buried under the Coroners Warrant, who deined the body might be taken to the grave.
