SHARNCOTT, or SHORNCOTE, is a township and small parish, 3 miles south from Cirencester, and north of Minety station, in the Hundred of Cricklade, Cirencester Union, North Wilts. The living is a rectory, in the patronage of the Lord Chancellor, value £150 per annum, including 35 acres of glebe; the Rev. John Graenly, M.A., is the incumbent, who resides at Salisbury; the Rev. William Bartram, M.A., is the curate. Here is a small parish church. The population is 29; the area in acres, about 485. Joseph Mill, Esq., owns nearly all the property. Mr. Baker, Esq., is lord of the manor.
