An inquest was held by Mr. Wilson, at Shrewton, on Friday the 7th inst., on the body of Robert Chandler, who died on the preceding day, from injuries received from the kick of a horse which he was riding. As he was by himself, it did not very clearly appear how the accident occurred; but it was supposed that he lost his seat and retained the reins, and that the horse trod upon him and kicked him. The horse was a very steady animal, and was found on the down the same evening. Verdict, "Accidental death." The deceased was a very respectable, industrious man, and has left a widow very near her confinement, and three little children.
