


Somerford Keynes

JOHN BOWLEY

a native of Somerford Keynes,
who died at Whitehaven,
December 14th 1911, did by Will
bequeath to th VICAR and
CHURCHWARDENS, for the time
being, of the parish of Somerford
Keynes £100, the interest thereof
to be spent in maintaining in good
order the graves and tombstones of
his Father, Mother, and Sister; in
the Churchyard. He also bequeathed
a further sum of £200, the interest
thereof to be applied for the benefit
of four poor men, and four poor women
residing in the said parish. He also
by Will directed that a Marble
Tablet should be placed in the
Church to record these legacies
