



CORONERS INQUESTS



Male Child Of Ann Beale

An inquest was held by Mr. Wilson, at Damerham, on Tuesday, on the body of the male child, aged six weeks, of Ann Beale, single woman. It appeared that the child had been suffering from a cold for some few days, but appeared no worse when put to bed on Friday night. On Saturday morning, about 2 o'clock, the mother found the child dead by her side. Mr. Clifton of Fordingbridge, examined the child, and was of opinion that its death was caused by suffocation and congestion of the lungs from bronchitis. The jury returned a verdict of "Died by the Visitation of God."
