

CORONERS INQUESTS



Stapleford - 1800-1849

1823

On Wednesday last, R. P. Whitmarsh, Esq. held an inquest at Stapleford, on the body of John Trueman, who had hung himself early in the morning. The deceased had been in a low desponding way for some time. Sufficient evidence of the deranged state of his mind having been adduced, the Jury returned their verdict accordingly. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal**, **11 August 1823**

1843

An inquest was also held by Mr. Wilson, on Thursday, at Wishford, on the body of Mr. Henry Bracher, who died the day before in consequence of severe injuries arising from a fall from his horse at Stapleford on the Monday preceding. Verdict, "Accidental death." Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 20 June 1843
